As shared in previous correspondence West Lakes Academy recognises the positive impact homework can have on students' learning. Students are expected to complete homework, it is a requirement. Homework is included in our home – academy agreement. This is available to view on our website

We work to support students and ensure that homework is issued via MILK, with a week to complete. We also operate a homework club. Homework Club takes place after school on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday nights until 5.30pm in the library. Homework Club is a quiet place where students can do their homework without disruption and with access to a wide range of resources including full ICT and printing facilities. There is support for learning and teachers are available to provide extra assistance as required.

We do expect all students complete all of their home learning tasks. If students fail to complete homework sanctions will be issued and persistent failure to complete homework could result in an exclusion up to and including permanent exclusion. We do acknowledge that this is an incredibly serious sanction, but we will not tolerate or accept students not completing homework.
